New in the price list are our wick holder, white dye ,solid gel wax, vegetable wax, and a great new range of floating candle moulds.

How to use Rubber Moulds

Pour in the wax , and when the wax has set break open the surface of the candle. Keep the surface broken and top as as normal. Remove from the mould while the candle is still very slightly warm. Grease the outside of the mould with washing up liquid before you slide it back on itself to make it easier to remove.

Try pouring wax dyed with white dye first into the mould first – wait until it has set about 2mm on the edge of the mould, pour out the wax and fill with a darker coloured wax.

What to do if you cannot remove a candle from other moulds

Try putting it in a fridge first – the additional cold may contract it enough for it to come out. if that doesn't work you will have to put the whole mould into hot water and then slide it out – this will ruin the candle and mean you have to clean the mould out!! To avoid this problem happening always make sure that you never top up over the original level of the candle - the wax can go down the small gap at the edge of the mould and form a wedge.

NON-ARRIVAL of goods. In the event that your order does not arrive within 14 days of your placing the order you must let us know. Please allow 8 working days for delivery.

SHORTAGES & BREAKAGES must be notified within 7 working days of receipt of your order.

In the unlikely event of an item being OUT OF STOCK you will only be charged for what is actually sent. We do not put goods on 'back order' but will always contact you to see if you still want the order if a significant proportion of it is unavailable. However, we do our best to keep stock levels up and seldom have to let people down. If you have paid by cheque we will send a re-fund for the goods we cannot supply.

UNWANTED GOODS. In accordance with your statutory rights we will accept back any goods you are not happy with as long as we are notified within 7 working days of the delivery of the order and they are received back at our warehouse in perfect condition. You are responsible for your own shipping costs when returning items to us. For your own protection we advise you to use recorded post when you return goods. When we receive the goods back in perfect condition we will refund you for the cost of the goods and our normal carriage costs. If the goods returned are not in perfect condition the Company reserves the right to charge a re-stocking fee. The liability of the return of the goods rests with the customer. We cannot accept back personalised goods.

HANDLING CHARGE where a special delivery charge has been agreed, for example for overseas delivery, overnight delivery, parcels over 25 kilos and deliveries to British islands and Scottish Highlands we reserve the right to impose a handling charge on unwanted goods, never to exceed the original cost of shipping the goods to you.

All goods are despatched by a National Carrier or post. Estimated delivery times are 3 to 8 working days from order confirmation. We will send an email confirming your order has been sent and you should receive your order within 48 hours of receiving the email. If you have not received your order within three working days of the E mail please let us know. Also please let us know if you have not heard from us or received your order within 2 weeks of placing your order. E mail addresses given are not always accurate and e mails we send can bounce back without our noticing. It is essential that we are notified by you if you have not received your orders - as otherwise we cannot claim on our insurance if it has gone astray. We cannot offer refunds on orders that do not turn up unless we have been notified within 2 weeks of your placing the order that this is the case. All measurements are approximate and slight variations occur.

We regret we cannot accept responsibility for the delays that do occasionally occur when using carriers. All parcels will require a signature on receipt. An address must be supplied where the parcel can be signed for. Should delivery be attempted when you are not at home our carrier will leave a card. You can then telephone them & arrange a time for delivery. If you are not in the second time the carrier tries to deliver you will be left a card & asked to pick up the parcel yourself from the depot. Smaller parcels, which may be sent by Royal Mail will have to be picked up from the Post Office if you are not in. If you ask for the parcel to be left without signature, for example 'in the porch' - we regret we cannot refund deliveries which our carriers say have been delivered but which have gone astray. If you fail to pick up the order you will be charged for the full cost of the carriage to us and the cost of returning the package to us.
